Comparative and transnational approaches to understanding Canada's past are also welcome.

The *CHR* publishes standard, full-length articles based on primary research.

The publication time frame for articles submitted to the *CHR* is approximately thirteen months. Articles published in the *CHR* will automatically be considered for the journal's annual 'Best Article' prize (<http://www.utpjournals.com/chr/CHR%20prize%202009.pdf>).
