

## Call for Papers

For its second 2008 issue, *Genocide Studies and Prevention* will be publishing a special issue featuring articles on *the aftermath of genocide*. The Co-editors of *GSP* invite submissions on this topic for consideration. The Co-editors invite innovative approaches to new as well as established areas of study. Papers might treat the topic through a comparative study of multiple genocides, a case analysis of a single genocide, or consideration of genocide in general. The co-editors offer the following suggestions for paper topics, but welcome submissions that address the aftermath of genocide in any other way as well. Manuscripts might offer analysis of the short- and long-term historical consequences of genocide and/or the psychological, political, ideological, economic, gender, cultural, social, and/or other impacts of genocide on victims, perpetrators, and bystanders, as well as their societies as a whole; or articles might discuss perpetrator–victim group relations, reparations, criminal justice, post-genocide political responses, and other such issues, from legal, ethical, and/or other perspectives. Articles might also consider the impact of past genocides on later genocides.

Submissions must conform to the general *GSP* guidelines. **The submission deadline is 15 February 2008.** Although not required, prior notification of the intent to submit a paper for consideration will be helpful for editorial planning purposes and appreciated. All submissions will receive a thorough peer review to determine whether or not they will be accepted for publication in the special issue. The peer review schedule will be rolling, and the author of each submitted manuscript will be notified in a timely manner of the result of the peer-review process.
