Approximately 90% of the volume and 70% of the value of all goods transported worldwide is carried by ships. The world of maritime transportation is full of important, interesting and challenging operations research problems, including ship routing and scheduling, maritime inventory routing, port or terminal management and cargo stowage onboard ships to mention a few. Despite its apparent importance, maritime transportation has received relatively little attention in the operations research literature, even though we have experienced an increased research interest during the recent years.

INFOR, the flagship journal of the Canadian Operational Research Society, invites researchers and practitioners interested in this area to submit publications for a special issue devoted to “*Maritime Transportation*.” Authors are invited to submit manuscripts dealing with all aspects of operations research models and methods in this area. Since the gap between state-of-the-art research and industry practice is large in this area, we especially appreciate contributions dealing with real-life applications.
